

# About the Chatham County Agricultural and Industrial Fair

After World War II, Achievement Day was held annually by the Home Demonstration and 4-H Clubs in Chatham County.

Achievement Day offered people a chance to display their talent or household arts for prizes. The Farm and Home Agent of Chatham County, Mildred Bright Payton, presented an idea for a carnival and county fair to be held annually, with the proceeds helping fund prizes for Achievement Day.

On May 30, 1949, the Farm and Home Organization voted sixteen to two to establish a county fair.

The first Chatham County Colored Agricultural Fair was held in 1950 on the Goldston Lumber Company grounds, which were rented for \$250. About 3,000 people endured the rain, slogged through the mud, and enjoyed the exhibits on display in a rented, leaky tent. Preparation of the fairgrounds that first time required a great deal of work, but in spite of the weather, the fair was considered a great success.

Over the decades The Chatham County Agricultural and Industrial Fair has changed its name and broadened its outreach to the total Chatham community, while remaining a family-friendly fair.

Today's visitors might not know our fair's history—your fair's history. While we are the oldest African-American fair in continuous operation in North Carolina, and one of the oldest in the USA, we take pride in welcoming all to our annual festivities!
